



# Wax Recommendations

## **PRIORITY HEALTH HURON MEADOWS INVITAIONAL "KRAZY KLASSIC".**

Huron Meadows, Brighton, MI  
12 km Classic race. 10:30 AM start

NOAA Forecast:

**Saturday Night:** Rain and snow, mainly after 1am. Low around 33. Chance of precipitation is 80%. Little or no snow accumulation expected.

**Sunday:** Rain and snow likely. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 36. Chance of precipitation is 60%. Little or no snow accumulation expected.

Start time temp about 34F. Mostly Cloudy.

Skis: A good pair of klister skis with a plus base, a soft tip and a high wax pocket.

### **SOLDA Glide wax:**

Base: Solda HC28 crayoned on a clean base. You could iron and scrape a layer of HC28. Follow with Solda UF 7.

Paraffin: Solda F40 Carbon Orange.

Top Coat: This may seem odd, but if it freezes up and you have the falling snow on snow that has iced and is glazing, apply a layer of Solda S30 powder, scrape lightly when it is still warm. Then apply a layer of Solda HP05 fluor powder.

If it doesn't freeze up and it is rainy, then go with Solda Fluor 100 or Fluor Gel.

### **Budget wax:**

Base: Solda HC28 + UF 7

Paraffin: Solda F31 Orange and F31 Yellow mixed 50/50.

### **Kick Wax:**

Binder: Apply a layer of your favorite klister binder, and then wait for morning.

Wax: If there is no new snow, go with a Rode Multigrade or Rode K50 sliver. Swix KR 70 could be a good choice.

If there is new snow, then cover the binder with a soft hard wax for wet, dirty snow. Try Rode Rossa or Yellow, or Swix KR65 or KR70.
