



WAX RECOMMENDATION

2008 Michigan Cup Sprints: Hanson Hills

Grayling, Michigan - Sunday, Feb 3rd

Forecast: Saturday night low 23F. Sunday high 31F. New Snow is in the forecast.

Base Prep: Clean skis with CH10 or BP99 (Nordic Base Prep) scrape and brush using Course Bronze Brush.

Structure: Linear - Swix Super Riller using the .5mm blade. Apply structure after waxing and brushing.

GLIDE WAX - FAST

Base Race Wax: Apply CH7, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

Or

Base Race Wax: NEW SWIX BLUE GLIDE - F6L Liquid

GLIDE WAX - FASTER

Race Wax: Apply LF8, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

GLIDE WAX - WICKED FAST

Base Race Wax: Apply HF8, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

Race Wax: Apply FC7 Powder. FC7 is ironed twice during application. Ironed, brushed back to powder form, and ironed again. Brush up using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164) after 1st ironing. After 2nd ironing, brush out with using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164). Final brush with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T0160).

Or

Race Wax: Apply FC1 Solid with Iron for durability and brush out using Horsehair then Fine Nylon brushes.

* FC1 Solid could be hand-corked in and brushed out with Fine Nylon Brush

FINALS Race Wax: Apply FC8 Powder. FC8 is ironed in ONLY once during application. Brush with using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164). Final brush with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T0160).

Or

FINALS Race Wax: Apply FC1 Solid with Iron for durability and brush out using Horsehair then Fine Nylon brushes.

* FC1 Solid can also be hand-corked in and brushed out with Fine Nylon Brush
