



# ***WAX RECOMMENDATION***

## EVENT

**Boyne Highlands Freestyle - Sunday March 9<sup>th</sup>**  
**Boyne Highlands Resort: Harbor Springs, Michigan**

**Forecast:** *Saturday night low 0 F, Sunday temp at race time around 12 F*

**Base Prep:** *Clean skis with SWIX CH10, BP88 or BP99 - scrape and brush using SWIX Course Bronze Brush(T0158) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Apply a layer of NEW SWIX MB77 Molly Base Prep. Scrape and brush. This is very important - to help open up the base to receive the wax.*

**Structure:** *Fine linear, Can be applied with the Swix Super Riller using the fine .25mm blade - after you have applied final race wax layer and then brush.*

## GLIDE WAX - FAST

**Base Race Wax:** *Apply CH6, scrape and brush using Medium Bronze Brush*  
**\* Repeat above for even faster skis! Polish with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160) after warm-up**

## GLIDE WAX - FASTER

**Race Wax:** *Apply LF4, scrape and brush using Medium Bronze Brush*  
**\* Repeat above for even faster skis! Polish with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160) after warm-up**

## GLIDE WAX - WICKED FAST

**Base Race Wax:** *Apply LF4, scrape and brush using Medium Bronze Brush*  
**\* Repeat above for even faster skis!**

**Race Wax: Race Wax: Race Wax:** *Apply FC7 Powder. FC7 is ironed twice during application. Ironed, brushed back to powder form, and ironed again. Brush up using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164) after 1<sup>st</sup> ironing. After 2<sup>nd</sup> ironing, brush out with using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164). Final brush with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T0160).*  
*Or*

**Race Wax:** *Apply FC1 Solid with Iron for durability and brush out using Horsehair then Fine Nylon brushes.*  
**\* FC1 Solid could be hand-corked in and brushed out with Fine Nylon Brush**
