

# WAX RECOMMENDATION

**EVENT:** Hanson Hills Classic

Grayling, Michigan - Sunday, February 17<sup>th</sup>

**Forecast:** Saturday night low 14F. Overnight snow anticipated. Sunday temps rising to 26F during the afternoon.

**Base Prep:** Clean skis with CH10 or BP088 scrape and brush using Course Bronze Brush. Clean kick zone with Swix base cleaner and Fiberlene, sand kick zone with 100grit sandpaper

Structure: Fine linear: Swix Super Riller using the .33mm blade.

## GLIDE WAX - FAST

**Base Race Wax:** Apply CH6, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

## GLIDE WAX - FASTER

Race Wax: Apply LF6, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

## GLIDE WAX - WICKED FAST

**Base Race Wax:** Apply LF6, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

Race Wax: Race Wax: Apply FC7 Powder. FC7 is ironed twice during application.

Ironed, brushed back to powder form, and ironed again. Brush up using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164) after 1<sup>st</sup> ironing. After 2<sup>nd</sup> ironing, brush out with using SWIX Stiff Black Nylon Brush (T0194) or NEW SWIX Wild Boar (T0164). Final brush with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T0160).

Race Wax: Apply FC1 Solid with Iron for durability and brush out using Horsehair then Fine Nylon brushes.

\* FC1 Solid could be hand-corked in and brushed out with Fine Nylon Brush

# KICK WAX

Base Kick Wax: Apply a thin layer of VG35 Base Wax (iron in or use heat gun) & cork smooth. This layer will add durability and act as a cushion.

Race Wax: Apply several layers of VR30 or V20 Green and cork in each layer. Cover with short layer of VR40 or V30 Blue if extra grip needed & cork smooth.
