

WAX RECOMMENDATION

EVENT – 2008 Michigan High School Championships Saturday, February 16th – BOYNE VALLEY LODGE

Morning Freestyle Races

Forecast: Friday night low 1F. Overnight snow anticipated. Saturday temps rising to 20F during the afternoon. More Snow in the Forecast!

Base Prep: Clean skis with CH10 or BP99 - scrape and brush using SWIX Course Bronze Brush(T0158) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Apply a layer of NEW SWIX MB77 Molly Base Prep. Scrape and brush. Clean kick zone with Swix base cleaner and Fiberlene, sand kick zone with 100grit sandpaper

Structure: Extra Fine linear: Swix Super Riller using the fine .25mm blade.

<u> Glide Wax - Fast</u>

Base Race Wax: Apply CH4, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

GLIDE WAX - FASTER

Race Wax: Apply LF4, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160). * Repeat above for even FASTER Skis!

<u> Glide Wax – Wicked Fast</u>

Base Race Wax: Apply LF4, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

* Repeat above for even FASTER Skis!

Race Wax: Apply LF3 Powder, scrape and brush using SWIX Medium Bronze Brush (T1620) or SWIX Fine Steel Brush (T0192). Polish using SWIX Blue Nylon Brush (T160).

* brush skis after on snow warm-up with SWIX Blue Nylon Brush
